Express Yourself with a Mandala

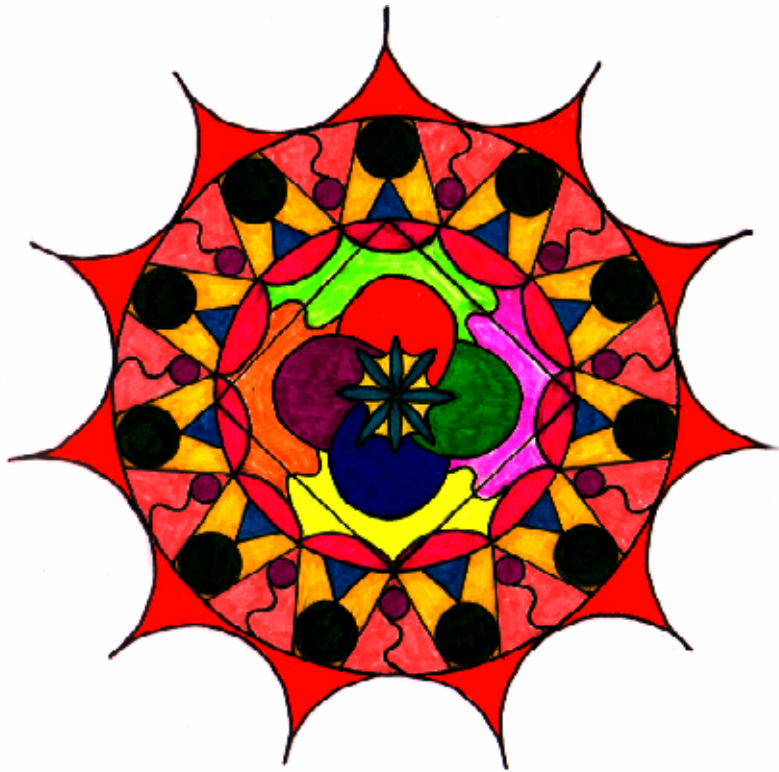
