**Grading:** Every in-class exam will be worth of 100 points as maximum, and the final exam will be worth of 200 points as maximum, the homework score will be scaled to 200 points as maximum. Totally there will be 700 maximal points.

The final grade will be calculated as follows:

- A around 630 700 points (more than 90%)
- B around 560 629 points (between 80% and 90%)
- C around 490 559 points (between 70% and 80%)
- D around 420 489 points (between 60% and 70%)
- F below 419 points (below 60%)

Attendance: There will be a 20 point bonus, added to your course score, for good class attendance. To earn this bonus, you are allowed to have at most 4 unexcused absences after the second week of term. Each unexcused absence after 4 will reduce the bonus by 5 points.
